Centre-based programs aim to provide opportunities for people with intellectual disabilities to learn practical and soft skills required for independent living. Each program will be run in small groups and will be tailored to participant goals.

A support coordinator can assist you to understand and implement your plan. QHH support coordinators are highly trained professionals who specialise in assisting participants to connect with mainstream, NDIS and community supports that align with the participants plan goals. QHH support coordinators pride themselves on ensuring participants are empowered to exercise choice and control over the supports they access and that their capacity to coordinate services is built.
